

RootBarrier™ Waterbag Installation guide

Step 1: Preparation

Check that the ground around the tree is free of sharp objects and debris to prevent damage to the Waterbag. Ensure that the tree trunk is suitable (max. approx. 30 cm in circumference) for a secure fit.

Step 2: Positioning around the trunk

Place the Waterbag around the tree trunk and ensure it fits snugly. Close the zip completely so that the bag sits securely around the trunk.

Step 3: Initial filling and activation

Insert a water hose deep into the opening of the Waterbag. First fill the bag with approximately 5–10 litres of water and shake the Waterbag gently by the loops. This helps to clear the drip holes for proper water release.

Step 4: Filling completely

Then fill the Waterbag completely with water. Ensure the bag is upright and evenly distributed around the trunk.

Step 6: Use

For best results, refill the Waterbag with fresh water preferably twice a week.
